Naturalization is the process by which U.S. citizenship is conferred upon a foreign citizen or national after he or she fulfills the requirements established by Congress in the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA).

Basic steps toward naturalization (become United States Citizen)

1. Download naturalization *form instructions* from USCIS website (N-400)
2. Download naturalization *form* from USCIS website (N-400)
3. Review document checklist on USCIS website
4. Send form, other required documents and fee to address found on USCIS website
5. Wait for appointment to give fingerprints & signature
6. Wait for interview to take English & civics test
7. Receive decision from USCIS (application approved or declined)
8. If application is approved, applicant will receive ceremony date
9. Take oath
10. Receive Certificate of Naturalization
